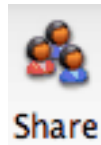
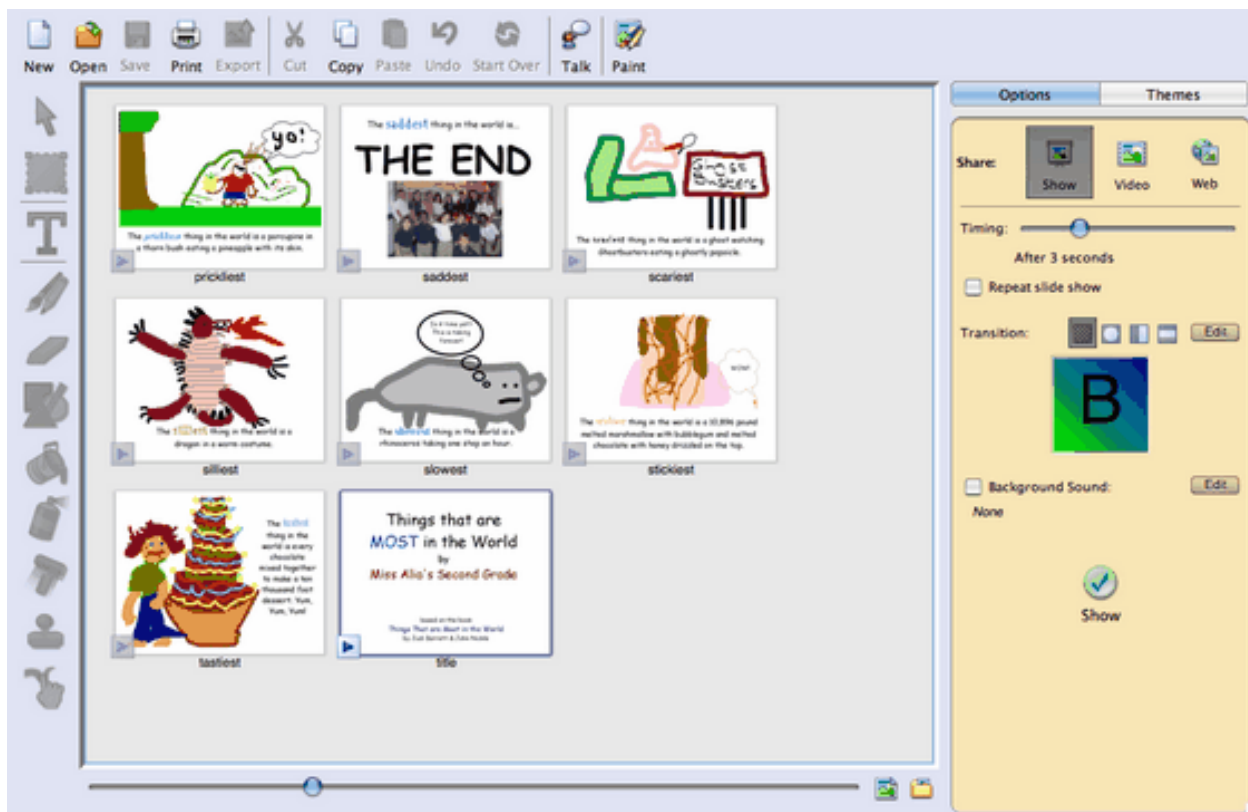


You can create a video with the pictures that are open in Pixie.

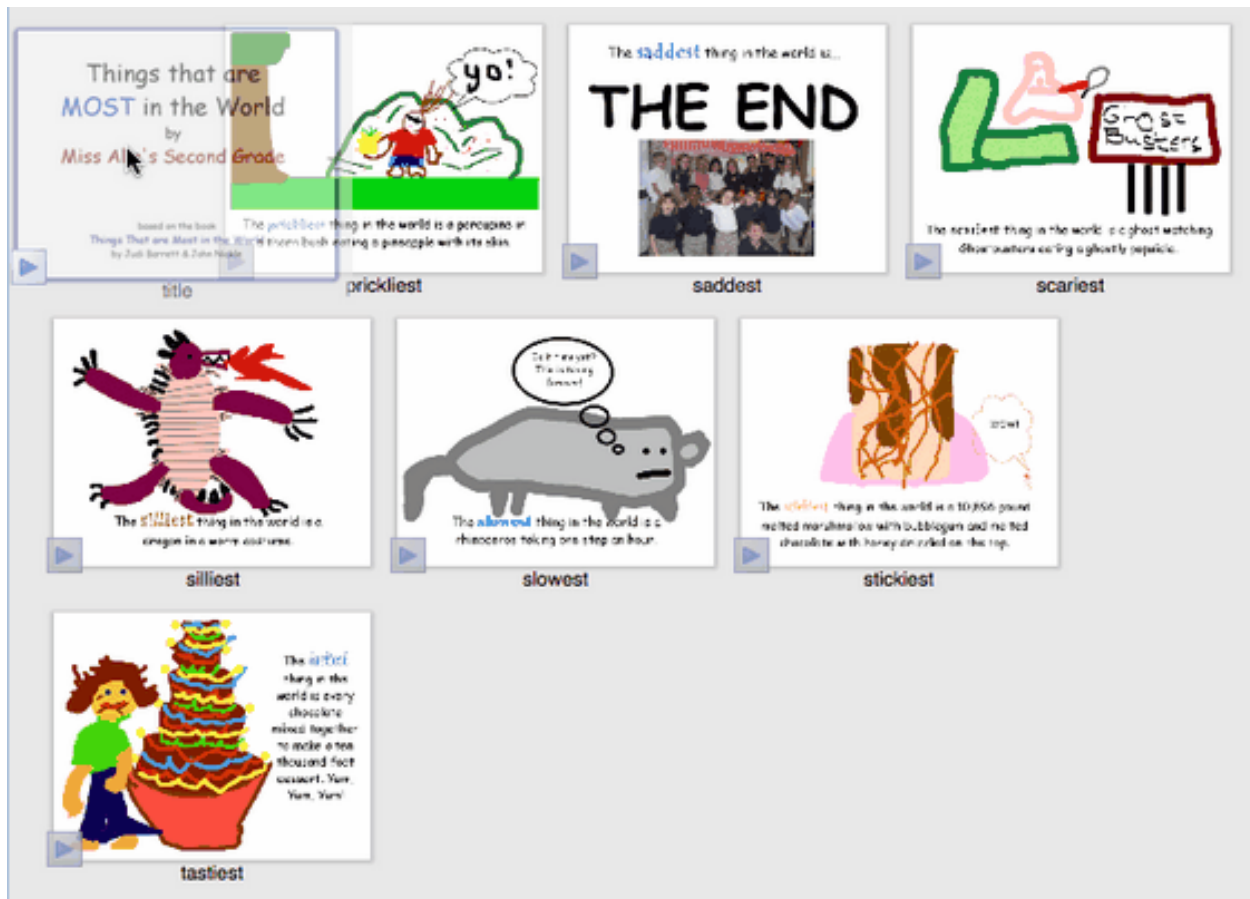
Click the Share button on the toolbar.



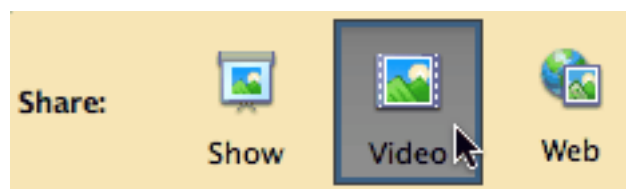
You will see a storyboard of your open pictures.



Click and drag the thumbnails to arrange the pictures in the order that you want them for the video.



Click the Video button in the Share editing panel.

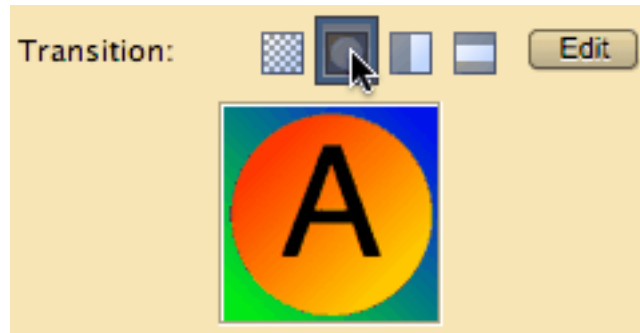


Click and drag the Timing slider to set the timing for the pictures.

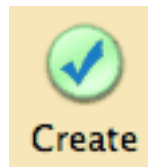


If pictures have a sound recorded with them, the sound duration will override this timing setting.

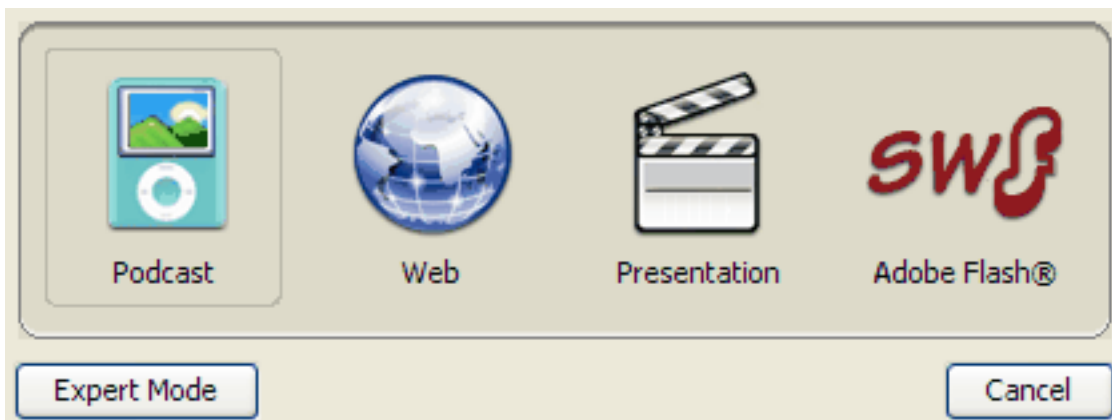
Click a Transition button to choose a transition.



Click the Create button to export the movie.



You will see the Create Video dialog.



Choose the method for sharing your video.

Click Podcast to create a movie you can share in a podcast through iTunes. Podcasts

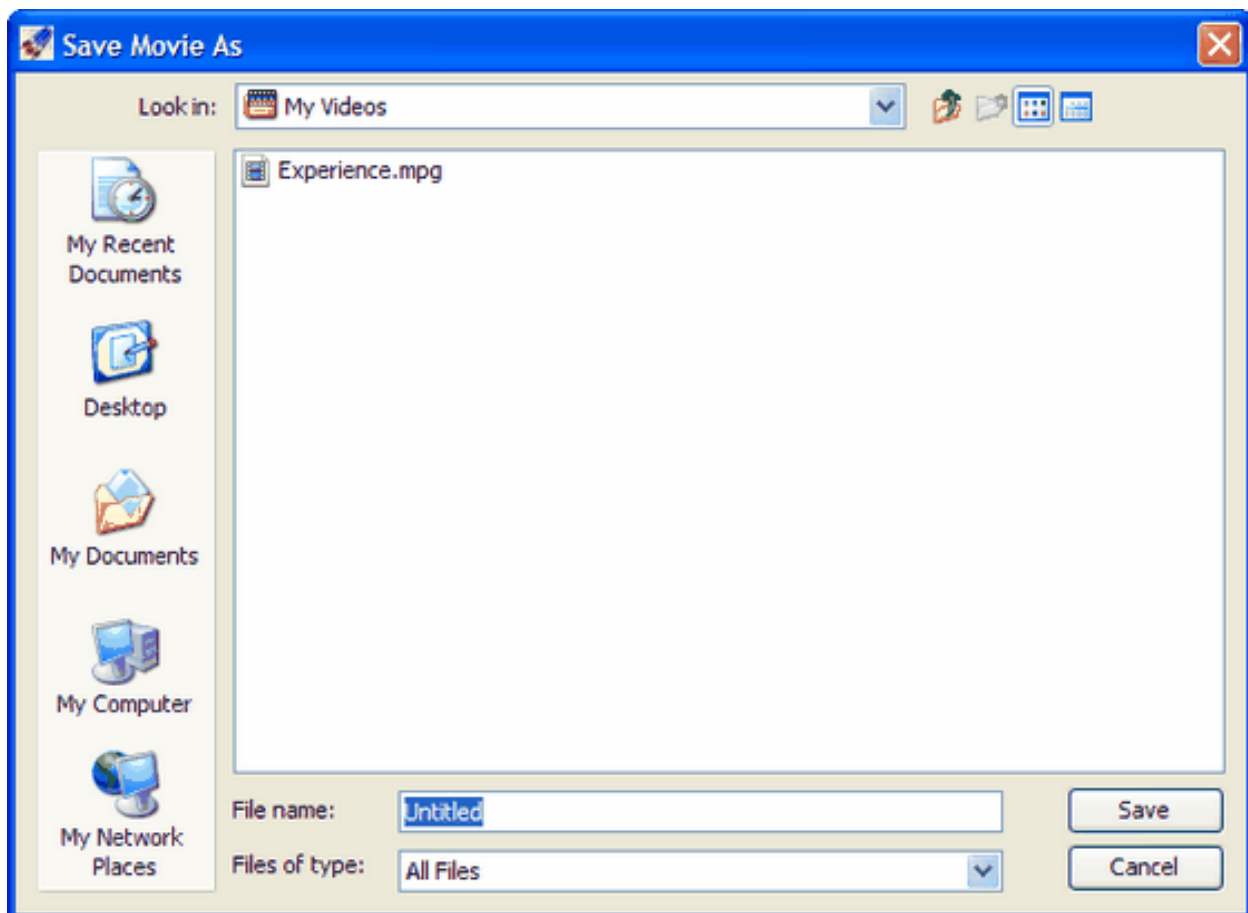
are 320x240 m4v files.

Click Web to create a movie you can share on a Web site. Web videos are 320x240 mov files.


Click Presentation to create a large movie to play on your computer. Presentation videos are 800x600 mov files on Macintosh and 800x600 avi files on Windows.

Click Flash to create an Adobe Flash animation. The Flash animation will create an SWF file and an HTML file to play the animation.

After making your choice, you will see the Save Movie As dialog.
