## Pixie® 2

### Printing with Pixie

Pixie 2 allows you to print your images in a number of different layouts, including comic books, booklets, trading cards, and more.

To print using these options, open the images you want to print. Once all of the images are open, click the **Share** button on the toolbar.



Use the storyboard to change the order of the images. Click and drag pictures into the order you want them to print.

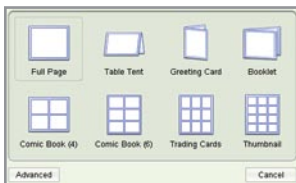


Click the **Print** button on the toolbar.



You will see the Print Pictures dialog.

Click a format for how you want the pictures to print.

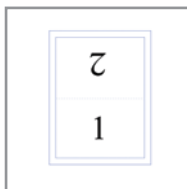


### Full Page

This option will print each of your open pictures as large as possible on a printed page using the default margins.

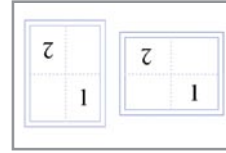
### Table Tent

This option will print two Pixie files onto one sheet of paper in portrait form. The pictures will be arranged so that the image on each side of the table tent is right-side up.



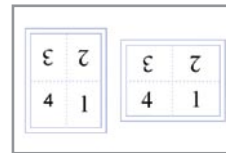
### Greeting Card

This option will print two Pixie files onto one piece of paper in either portrait or landscape orientation. The pictures will rotate so that you can fold the paper in half and then in half again to make a card out of one sheet of paper. Picture 1 will show on the front and picture 2 will show on the inside.



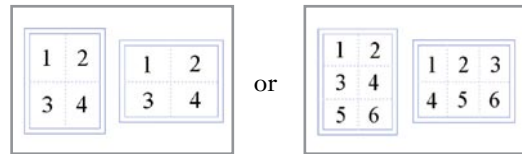
### Booklet

This option will print four Pixie files onto one piece of paper in either portrait or landscape orientation. The pictures will rotate so that you can fold the paper in half and then in half again to make a booklet out of one sheet of paper. Picture 1 will show on the front, picture 2 will show on the inside left, picture 3 will show on the inside right, and picture 4 will show on the back.



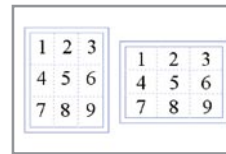
### Comic Book-4 and Comic Book-6

This option will print four or six Pixie files onto one piece of paper in either portrait or landscape orientation.



### Trading Cards

This option will print nine Pixie files onto one piece of paper in either portrait or landscape orientation.



### Thumbnail

This option will print twelve Pixie files onto one piece of paper in either portrait or landscape orientation.
