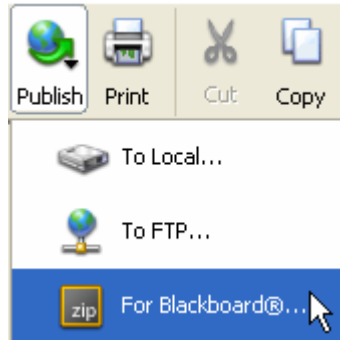


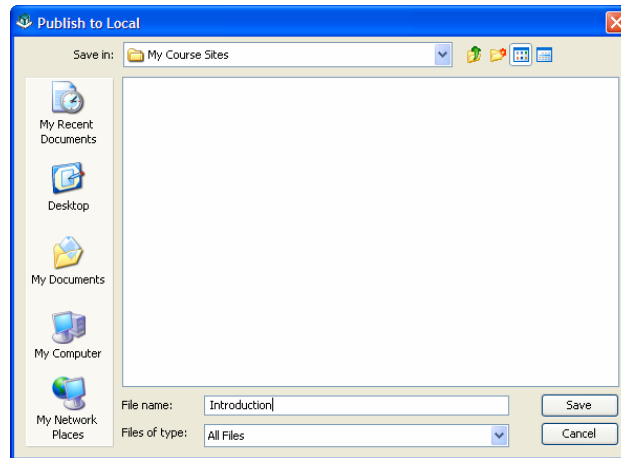
You can publish your WebBlender site for use in a Blackboard® course. Then, you can upload it and add it as a document to a Blackboard course.

## ***Publishing in WebBlender***

When you finish your site, click the Publish button on the toolbar and choose For Blackboard.



You will see the Publish dialog.



Choose a place to save the published site.

Click the Save button.

A zip file will be created that contains your published site.



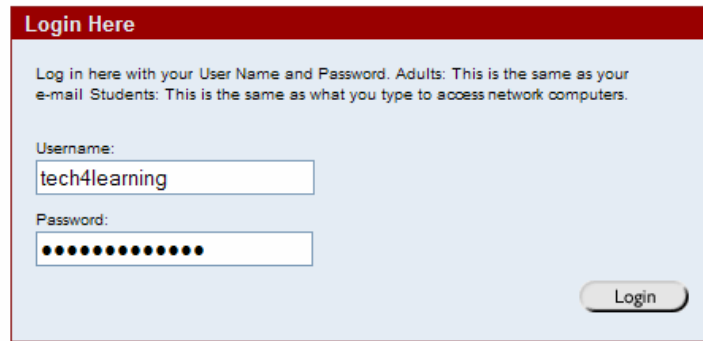
Close WebBlender.



Click the Courses tab.

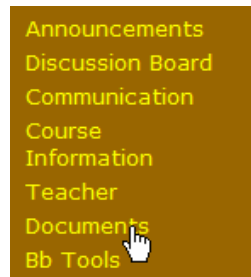
Click the hyperlink in your Course List for the course you want to add the site to.

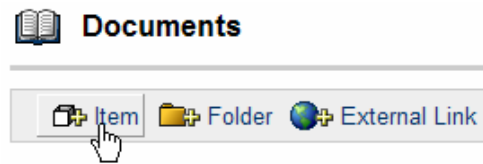
Click the Documents link on the left side of the window.



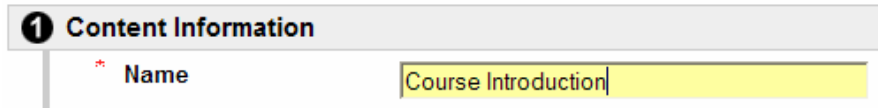
Click the Edit View link.



Click the Add Item button.

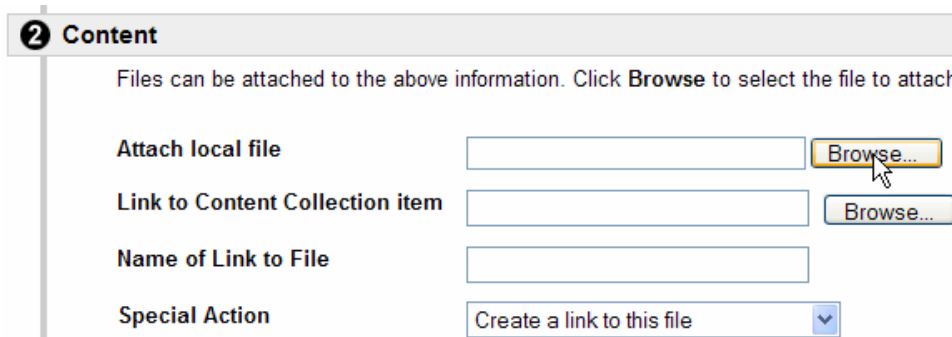


At the Add Item page, type a name for the site in the Name field.

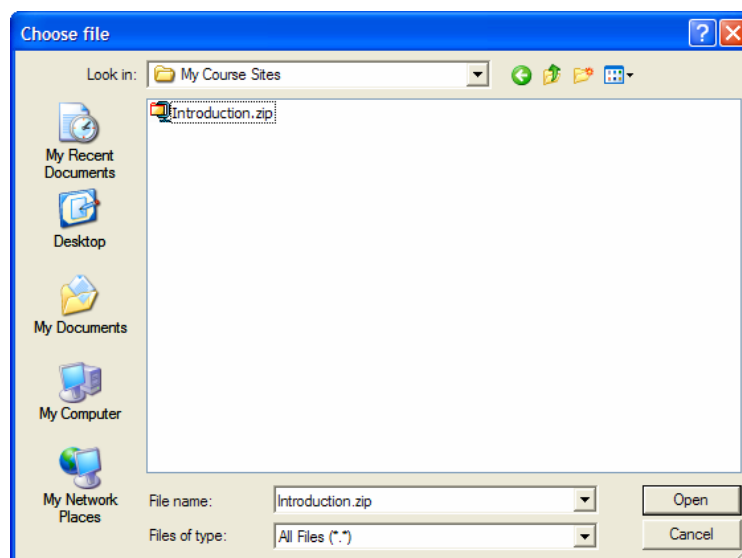


Scroll down to the Content section.

Click the Browse button next to the Attach local file field.



You will see the Choose file dialog.



Locate the zip file you published from WebBlender.

Select the file and click the Open button.

Type a name for the site in the Name of Link to File field.

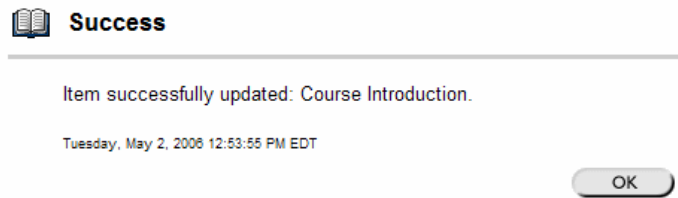

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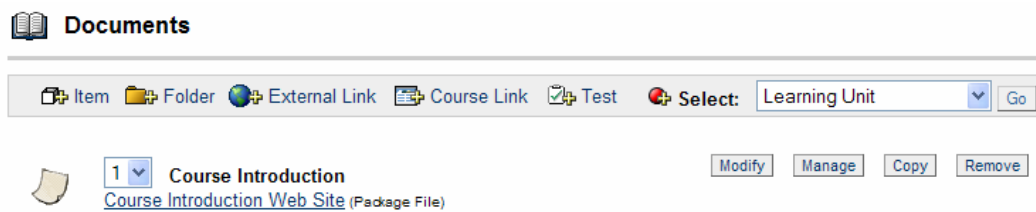
